**2019 ACT TEAMS RAPID  
CHESS CHAMPIONSHIP!**



*Ever wanted to be part of one of those junior interschool rapid events? Do you miss playing them back in your junior days? Want to show Canberra which club is boss? Want one of those cool FIDE rapid ratings? Well, wait no longer...*

- When:** Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2019, 10am until approximately 4pm (registration from 9.30).
- Where:** ACT Junior Chess Centre, Campbell High School hall, Treloar Crescent, Campbell  
*(Please note: the school hall can be cold so bring a jacket on the day!).*
- Who:** Anyone! Adults and juniors, young and old, this event is open for all! We encourage players hoping to play in the Australian Schools Teams Championship event to enter as a team.
- Cost:** \$40.00 per team. Entries to be paid on the day. Membership to the ACT Junior Chess League or ACT Chess Association is not required for this event.
- Time Control:** 15 minutes + 5 seconds per move from move 1. Games will be FIDE and ACF rated. 7 rounds will be played through the day.
- Entries:** to Alana Chibnall [alanachibnall@hotmail.com](mailto:alanachibnall@hotmail.com) by Friday 20th September, including player's names (in board order), captain's name and team name. **Late entries will only be accepted on the day if space permits.**
- Lunch:** Bring your own lunch, or Pizza and a drink is available for \$8 per player (\$7 per child). Snacks and drinks can be purchased throughout the day.
- Teams:** Teams are made up of 4 players. The average rating per team cannot exceed **1600**. E.g. Board 1: 2100, Board 2: 1700, Board 3: 1500, Board 4: 1100 = 6400, divided by 4 players = 1600 rating. Unrated players will be given a provisional rating of 1000 if they do not have any form of ACF/FIDE rating.
- Ratings used in order of priority: ACF Quick, FIDE Rapid, ACF Standard. Players must play in rating order (within 50 points)
- Prizes:** Trophies for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> winning team. Medals for best scorer on each board.
- The best ACT club team will win the Larko Cup trophy for their club, and each player on the team will receive a medal. All players in a club team must have played in at least one multi-week club event in 2019 (such as a rapid or standard tournament) to be eligible.

**This event is a fundraiser for the Australian Schools Teams Championship being held in Canberra on 30 November/1 December 2019.**
